United States[®] Census 2020

WHAT'S THE CENSUS?

- Official count of all people living in the U.S. It's been done once every 10 years since 1790! Everyone should be counted.
- The census will ask things like name, gender, age, birthday, race/ethnicity, and each person's relationship to the person filling out the form.



WHO BENEFITS?

- Our community gets federal funds for schools, health care, roads, and other vital services.
- Each person counted could add around \$18,000 in funding for West Michigan over ten years!
- The census count determines the number of delegates Michigan will have in the U.S. House of Representatives.



HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

In March 2020, every household will receive a mailed invitation to fill out the census form by:

- Computer/smart-phone (online form available in 12 non-English languages).
- By phone.
- By mail.
