Street barricades are required for block party road closures. City staff will deliver these barricades to a corner of the block party area on the day of the party. Barricades are to be placed back in the delivery location for pick-up after your event.

Disclaimer: The City does not guarantee Police and/or Fire vehicles will be able to attend. Also, it is to be noted, if they are attending your event and an emergency arises, they will need to leave. We will forward your request to the appropriate department and honor as many requests as possible, barring no emergencies.

The following rules shall govern the closure of a street for a block party:

- The applicant must be at least 18 years of age and a resident of the block being closed.
- Block party timeframes: Begin any time during daylight hours after 8:00 AM but must end and clear by 11:00 PM.
- Block parties are intended for multiple houses in the block party area only and not single household parties.
- The City of Zeeland has a local ordinance that controls the use of alcohol in any public event. The ordinance prohibits the following: consume, possess, or knowingly have under his/her control any open container of an alcoholic beverage in any public park, public school property or upon any public street or public sidewalk.
- The applicant automatically becomes the contact person for the block party and as such, he/she must:
 - Place and remove street closure devices (barricades);
 - Monitor and regulate noise resulting from the party;
 - Clear the area in case of an emergency;
 - To keep clear one traffic lane for emergency vehicles through the entire block;
 - Clean up the block party area upon completion.
