2. For work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.
3. For residential structures having less than 3,500 square feet of habitable space.

V. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

I hereby certify the electrical work described on this permit application shall be installed by myself in my own home in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the State Electrical Code and shall not be enclosed, covered up, or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the City Electrical Inspector. I will cooperate with the City Electrical Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.

VI. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, 1972 P.A. 230, MCL125.1523A prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. VIII. FEE CLARIFICATION

ITEM #18 (MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE):

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application must include the application fee service plus the number of park sites.

When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. Work shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor.

When setting a HUD mobile home or a pre-manufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

IX. PERMIT STIPULATIONS

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been approved by the City of Zeeland. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The phone number for inspection requests will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the Building Department providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
